MASSC analysis

The Dutch interviews have been finalized, which means it is time to fully focus on transcribing and coding the Dutch interviews. Almost all interviews are currently transcribed, and half of the interviews are coded. We are starting with the systematic analysis of the data to report on our findings.

Simultaneously, the focus lies on the preparation of the international interview setup. Both the interview guide and protocol have progressed and we will start interviewing public procurement experts around the world in a few weeks time.



Next up

The next months, the focus lies on finalizing the Dutch report, which will be publicly available in the summer. Whilst together with the IRSP network, we will conduct interviews in over 20 countries for our international analysis.
